

# Out Into the Big Wide Lake



## Questions:

- How do people get what they need at grandparent's house? (grandpa makes deliveries in the boat)
- Describe the grumpy man on the dock waiting for Kate and grandpa. (he is rude, his name is Walter, he is grandpa's brother)
- Why did Walter count all of his groceries? Have you ever met someone who needed to count things many times or touch each thing in a certain way? (Sometimes people have a disability that makes them like to count things, touch all things, or put things in certain places.)
- How did Kate feel when she first went to her grandparents, and how did she feel when she got home from the adventure?
- What can you do if you meet someone who is like Walter? (don't be upset by their ticks- be nice even if they are not being nice)
- Compare City living with Rural living- setting on the lake.

## Extensions:

- Draw or write about a time when you met someone who did things very differently than you. Maybe you thought they were rude or unkind.
- Make partners and interview each other about a time when they had to be brave.
