Established in 1923 as the Toledo Society for the Blind, a non-profit 501 (c) 3 organization, the agency has grown to serve an 18-county region in Northwest Ohio as well as parts of Southeast Michigan and Central Ohio.

The Sight Center also operates a unique retail store called The Shop. The Shop makes it easier for people who are blind or visually impaired to get the tools that help them live independently. In addition to providing solutions for everyday living, The Shop is a doorway to hope and a safe place to begin exploring the possibilities of doing more while seeing less.
